Together we bring joy

Together with you, who read this letter and gave us of your time, prayer, money, we were able to bring joy and hope in the lives of dozens and hundreds of children and families in need in the last three months.

Our National Day, Christmas time and New Year's Eve (with presents, lights, traditional food), and then Dani's birthday party were events we were blessed to be able to celebrate in the group homes of PRR.



The end of the first semester in January this year brought our staff the joy of the hard worker – all our residential children promoted well and some of them got scholarships. The restrictions in Romania relaxed considerably and the students physically participate in classes. The three boys in the 9th grade adapted quickly, and are well seen. They commute by train to school and enjoy a normal social life. Florin is in his 8th grade; he took the simulations at the capacity exam that he will have in June. We support him as much as we can for this important exam and for the future, as he desires to become a professional car mechanic.

Among the extracurricular activities, the children were happy to work in the yard and indoors. All the children had their hair cut – a nice lady from the community offered to help with that. Some of the boys are eager to learn how to cook, so they are very active in the kitchen.















FAMILIES IN NEED – The pandemic has greatly affected our society; there are more and more families who live in sheer poverty. Studies say that out of 5 families in the rural areas only 1 or 2 afforded to buy small Christmas presents for their children. Even if we are in the EU, there are so many children living in the cold, don't have the bare necessities, and even go to bed on an empty stomach.

We did all we could to help the families in our care (200 people) with food, clothing and shoes. Some families asked us to help them with medicines, so we paid for that too. Besides all that help, we supplied a few families with fire-wood and also distributed Christmas presents to all the children in our care and, at the same time we shared with them and their families about the greatest gifts of all, Jesus Christ who came to save us.

All this work for the families in need is done by our staff in their free time.

It's worthwhile to mention here that we continued to assist some of the families that used to send their children to our former day centre in Constanța, through our volunteer, Lidia, who used to work for the day centre.

In some cases, The General Directorate of Social Assistance and Child Protection and Town halls asked for our help to intervene and offer material help to certain families.
